Tian'anmen Square: Spanning 880 meters north to south and 500 meters east to west, this 440,000-square-meter urban square is the world's largest city center square, capable of accommodating 1 million people for simultaneous gatherings. The complex features iconic landmarks including Tiananmen Gate, the Monument to the People's Heroes, Chairman Mao Memorial Hall, the Great

Hall of the People, the National Museum of China, and Zhengyangmen. These structures serve as solemn memorials honoring revolutionary martyrs and the nation's founding leader, functioning as vital hubs for patriotic education and revolutionary heritage preservation.

the Palace Museum: The Forbidden City in Beijing, formerly known as the Purple Forbidden City, served as the imperial palace of China's Ming and Qing dynasties. Located at the heart of Beijing's central axis, this architectural marvel epitomizes ancient Chinese palace design. Centered around its iconic Three Great Halls, the complex spans 720,000 square meters with a floor area of approximately 150,000 square meters. It comprises over seventy palaces and more than 9,000 rooms, standing as one of the world's largest and best-preserved wooden structures among ancient architecture.

Mutianyu Section of the Great Wall: Visiting the Great Wall, known as one of the Nine Great Fortresses under heaven, makes you feel the heroic vow of "not being a true hero until reaching the Great Wall". With its towering walls and interconnected crenellations, it has been a strategic military stronghold since ancient times. Historically, the Mutianyu section of the Great Wall served as a crucial gateway to protect the capital.

Dynasty Emperors: Nestled in the southern foothills of Tianshou Mountain within Beijing's Changping District, approximately fifty kilometers from Tiananmen Square, this imperial mausoleum complex is situated in a small basin surrounded by mountains on three sides (east, west, and north). The burial grounds are embraced by rolling hills with plains at their center, while a meandering stream winds through the area before the mausoleum complex. Covering over 120 square kilometers, the mausoleum complex interments the remains of 13 emperors, 23 empresses, one imperial noble consort, and dozens of palace attendants who were buried alongside the deceased. It stands as the

world's most intact imperial burial complex, containing the largest number of imperial interments。

Shichahai: In addition to its large beautiful lake, Shichahai is also a famous historical block in Beijing. There are many historic sites such as the former residences of famous people and princely mansions scattered among them. These hutongs are the cultural characteristics of Beijing and the root of old Beijing. To experience the taste of old Beijing, it is essential to visit the hutongs。

With its towering walls and interconnected crenellations, it has been a strategic military stronghold since ancient times. Historically, the Mutianyu section of the Great Wall served as a crucial gateway to protect the capital.

12:00--13:00 Lunch

14:30--14:30 arrive **【Dynasty Emperors】** (The tour lasts 120 minutes)

Covering an area of more than 120 square kilometers, the mausoleum is the largest imperial mausoleum in the world with the remains of 13 emperors, 23 empresses, one imperial concubine and dozens of palace people who died in burial.

18: 00 Return to the city and get off the station by transportation

1. Transportation: air-conditioned tourist bus.
