The five-day trip includes Tian'anmen Square, the Palace Museum, Mutianyu Great Wall, Ming Tombs, the Summer Palace, the Temple of Heaven, The Yonghe Temple, Shichahai and the Olympic Park.

Tian'anmen Square: With a length of 880 meters, a width of 500 meters and an area of 440,000 square meters, it is the largest urban central square in the world and can hold a gathering of one million people at the same time.

The square features iconic landmarks including Tiananmen Gate, the Monument to the People's Heroes, Chairman Mao Memorial Hall, Great Hall of

the People, National Museum of China, and Zhengyangmen Gate. These structures, serving as solemn memorials to revolutionary martyrs and the nation's founding leader, stand as vital sites for patriotic education and preserving revolutionary heritage.

the Palace Museum: The Forbidden City in Beijing, formerly known as the Purple Forbidden City, served as the imperial palace of China's Ming and Qing dynasties. Located at the heart of Beijing's central axis, this architectural marvel epitomizes ancient Chinese palace design. Centered around its iconic Three Great Halls, the complex spans 720,000 square meters with a floor area of approximately 150,000 square meters, comprising over seventy palaces and more than 9,000 rooms. Recognized as one of the world's largest and best-preserved wooden structures among ancient architecture, it remains an enduring testament to China's architectural heritage.

Mutianyu Section of the Great Wall: Visiting the Great Wall, known as one of the Nine Great Fortresses under heaven, makes you feel the heroic vow of "not being a true hero until reaching the Great Wall". With its towering walls and interconnected crenellations, it has been a strategic military stronghold since ancient times. Historically, the Mutianyu section of the Great Wall served as a crucial gateway to protect the capital.

Dynasty Emperors: Nestled at the southern foot of Tianshou Mountain in Beijing's Changping District, approximately fifty kilometers from Tiananmen Square, this imperial mausoleum complex is situated in a small basin surrounded by mountains on three sides (east, west, and north). The burial grounds are embraced by rolling hills with a central plain, while a meandering stream flows before the mausoleum. Covering over 120 square kilometers, the complex interments the remains of 13 emperors, 23 empresses, one imperial concubine, and dozens of palace attendants who were buried alongside them. As the world's most intact imperial burial site, it holds the distinction of being

the largest imperial mausoleum complex containing such a vast number of imperial interments。

the Summer Palace: The Summer Palace, a royal garden built in 1750 during the 15th year of the Qianlong reign of the Qing Dynasty, covers an area of 3.009 square kilometers, with water covering about three-quarters of it. It is a large natural landscape garden with Wanshou Mountain and Kunming Lake as its main features。

Shichahai: In addition to its large beautiful lake, Shichahai is also a famous historical block in Beijing. There are many historic sites such as the former residences of famous people and princely mansions scattered in it. These hutongs are the cultural characteristics of Beijing and the root of old Beijing. To experience the taste of old Beijing, it is essential to visit the hutongs。

Olympic Green : Located in Chaoyang District at the northern end of Beijing's central axis, Beijing Olympic Park spans 11.59 square kilometers. As the main venue for the 2008 Beijing Olympics and the world's first "Double Olympic" park, it was recognized as a National Sports Industry Demonstration Base in 2013. Leveraging its comprehensive facilities, the park has hosted over 10,000 large-scale events including major international conferences, performances, and high-profile exhibitions, with nearly 1,000 significant international activities held there. It has gradually emerged as the premier destination for global competitions, cultural performances, and international exchanges。

08:30After breakfast, the guide and driver went to the hotel to pick up the guests

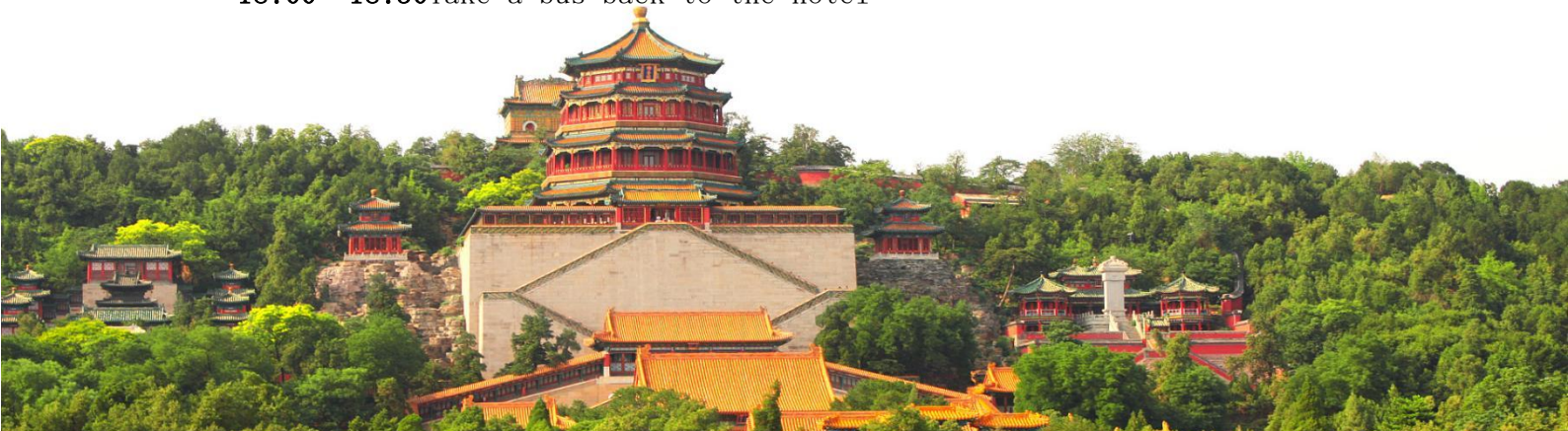

The Summer Palace has a clever artistic conception and plays a significant role in the history of Chinese and foreign garden art. It is a rare masterpiece of garden art in the world! The Summer Palace is mainly composed of two parts: Longevity Hill and Kunming Lake。

14:50--16:30Visit the venues of the opening and closing ceremonies of the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games **【bird nest】** exterior、National Aquatics Center **【Water Cube】** exterior 、 **【Exquisite Pagoda】** exterior 、 The Olympic Park is huge, Walking is hard, From a distance, it is the pinnacle of architectural history. It is the only sightseeing tower in the world composed of five independent towers. It is the highest point in the legend of feng shui **【Beijing Olympic Tower】** Outscape and other architectural landscapes such as dragon-shaped water system 。

With its towering walls and interconnected crenellations, this strategic fortress has been a coveted military stronghold since ancient times. 14:30--14:30 arrive **【Dynasty Emperors】** (The tour lasts 120 minutes) Covering an area of more than 120 square kilometers, the mausoleum is the largest imperial tomb complex in the world with the best preservation, burying 13 emperors, 23 empresses, one imperial concubine and dozens of palace people.
